

Bunny Doll

What you need:

- Sewing Machine & Thread
- Scissors, Needle & Pins
- White Adhesive Felt
- Lightweight Felt
- Black Buttons



Step 1: Fold Lightweight Felt in half, pin down and cut out Bunny Doll pieces. Inner Ear pattern should be cut from Adhesive Felt. Peel off the backing and stick to two Bunny Ears. Sew limbs and ears at 1/4" (0.6cm) turn pieces inside out. Stuff Legs and Arms with scrap felt or fabric. **Do not stuff the Ears.*




Step 2: Pin Ears and Arms to the Body, following pattern guides. Sew Back and Front Bunny Body together at 1/4" (0.6cm). Starting from the Back bottom, sew pieces together as far as you are able.



Step 3: Turn bunny inside out and handstitch the front of the body closed. Stuff Body with scraps.



Step 4: Pin Legs in place inside the bottom opening of the body and sew closed at 1/2" (1.3cm).



Step 5: Cut out Dress pieces from Lightweight Felt. Sew shoulder, side seams and waist at 1/4" (0.6cm), leaving the back open. **Optional: Use Stretch Lace Trim for the skirt to complete the look.*



Step 6: Dress your Bunny up in its fancy new dress and carefully handstitch the back together. **Note: Start sewing from the waist up to more easily match up the seams. Then, from the waist down, separately stitch the lace and felt together.*



Step 7: Handstitch Button eyes and nose to your Bunny's face.

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
