

## CHICKEN CAT TOY


## What you need:

- Aida Cloth
- Large Jingle Bell
- Marker & Scissors
- Fusible Interfacing
- Lightweight Felt
- Sewing Machine & Thread





Step 1: Cut out Body from your chosen material. We used Aida Cloth and Fusible Interfacing for added stability. Use a marker to draw out the dotted lines, from the Body pattern, on the wrong side of the fabric.



Step 2: Cut out the Feather, Comb and Beak from Lightweight Felt.




Step 3: Create a fringed edge, by cutting between the notches on the pattern.



Step 4: Pin the patterns from Step 2 in place, using the Body pattern as a reference. Sew the Comb at 1/8" (0.3cm), and the Feather at 3/8" (1cm).

Step 5: Sew the beak, on the right side of the fabric, at 1/4" (0.6cm) to keep it in place.



Step 6: Fold the Body into shape, following the guidelines from Step 1. Sew at 1/2" (1.3cm), but leave a 2" (5cm) opening on one side.



Step 7: Turn your Chicken inside out and stuff with scraps. Add a Jingle Bell or two to the inside. Handstitch the opening closed and draw on eyes with a marker. Now your Chicken Cat Toy is ready!

*Safety Tip:* Never let your pets play unsupervised with homemade toys.
