

DIY FACE MASK

& NECK STRAP

Never lose your mask again!

Materials:

- 0.2m of fabric 1
- 0.2m of fabric 2
- 0.2m of interfacing
- 0.4m of 1/4" elastic
- Swivel hook & D-ring set
- Scissors
- Tape Measure
- Pins
- Thread
- Sewing Machine
- Iron
- Biased Tape Maker (opt)



Seam allowance = 1/4" (0.6cm)

With right sides together, cut 1 pattern of each main fabric, lining fabric and interfacing.

Fuse the interfacing pieces to the wrong side of the lining fabric (2) as shown.

Pin main and lining fabric pieces together along curved edge and stitch. Press seams open.

Cut the elastic into two 13-16cm pieces, add a D-ring to each and pin to side corners. Pin the main and lining fabric pieces right sides together with the elastic in between.

Sew around the entire mask leaving a 3" (7cm) opening along the bottom. Turn right side out and press. Top stitch along the edge of the entire mask.



6.

Cut a 45cm x 5cm strip of fabric for the neck strap. Using a bias tape maker, fold and press the strip into 1/2" (1.3cm) width with raw edges folded inside. Topstitch the edge of the strap to finish. Fold each end 1/4" (0.6cm), press and insert through the swivel hook bar. Stitch in place.
