

# Nautical FLIP FLOPS

## Materials



- 1 Pair of flip flop sandals
- 1m of 7mm Large Twisted Cord - Dark Navy 5078000695
- 1 pair of Cord with Tassels - Red 5200100325
- Decorative Gold Tassels - 5200102165
- Scissors
- Hot Glue
- 10mm Jump Rings - Gold 6442010165

## Tying the Knot

Start off your flip flops by tying this knot around the strap. Be sure to hot glue the knot to secure it and then glue the cord to the straps.

Step 5

Open a jump ring and push it through the rope.



Step 6

Trim the loops from the tops of the tassels and attach to the jump rings.



Step 7

Trim the tassels to a length you're comfortable wearing.



# Comfy Cloth FLIP FLOPS



## Materials

1 Pair of flip flop sandals  
Cotton Fabric  
Thread  
Scissors  
Sewing Machine



Step 1

Cut 2 pieces 61x10cm (24x4")  
Cut 2 pieces 31x10cm (12x4")



Step 2

Cut and remove the plastic strap from each flip flop.



Step 3

Fold each piece with the right sides together lengthwise, then stitch along edge.



Step 4

Turn the right sides of the fabric out and lightly press.

Step 5



Cut points in each end



Step 6

Use the smaller pieces to make the toe loop by threading the points through the top hole. Thread the larger pieces through the toe loop and push the fabric ends through the side holes. Try them on your feet to check how tight to make knots.



Step 7

On the flipflop bottom use a basic double knot to tie the 2 toe loop ends together. Make them as tight and small as possible. Use an overhand knot to tie each end of the foot bands to the bottom. Trim ends and push knot into indentations to be as flat as possible.
