

Mini Mitten Ornaments

MATERIALS:

- One ball of #4 medium weight yarn
- 5mm (US 8) knitting needle
- Stitch holder
- Yarn needle

ABBREVIATIONS:

CO = cast on

K = knit

 $\mathbf{P} = purl$

inc = increase

K2tog = knit two sts together as one

P2tog = purl two sts together as one

Rep = repeat

st(s) = stitch(es)

KNITTING PATTERN:

CO 22

Row 1-6: *K1, P1; Rep from * to end of row

Row 7: K all sts

Row 8: P all sts

Row 9: K 10, inc 2 sts, K 12 (24sts)

Row 10 and all even rows: P all sts

Row 11: K 10, inc, K 2, inc, K all remaining sts (26sts)

Row 13: K 10, inc, K 4, inc, K all remaining sts (28 sts)

Row 15: K 10, CO 2 sts, place the next 8 sts on stitch holder, K all remaining sts

Row 16: P all sts

Row 17: K all sts

Row 18: P all sts

Row 19-24: Rep rows 17-18

Row 25: *K2tog; Rep from * until the end of the row (11sts)

Row 26: *P2tog; Rep from * to last st, P1 (6sts)

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Using the yarn needle, weave tail through 6 sts, pull to secure.

Thumb Row 1: Place the 8 sts back onto knitting needle. Attach yarn and K first st, inc, K6, inc, K (10sts)

Row 2: P all sts Row 3: K all sts Row 4: P all sts Row 5: *K2tog; Rep from * until the end of row (5sts)

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Using the yarn needle, weave tail through 5 sts, pull to secure.

Finishing: Sew together all side seams and weave in all ends. Rep pattern for second mitten. Cut yarn 20cm (8") long, and tie each end to the bottom side seam of each cuff, on the thumb side. Tie a knot at the top, leaving a loop to easily hang the ornament.

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
