



# make your own Pom Pom Necklace

## Materials!

For this project you will need the following:

- 1 package Tailor 6mm Open Jump Rings
- 1 package Accents 20mm D-Rings
- 48 cm/19" of 4mm Metal Chain
- 30cm/12" of 13 mm Pom Pom Fringe
- 30cm/12" of 13mm Cotton Trim
- 96cm/ 38" of 16mm Saddle Stitch Grosgrain
- 30cm/12" of 3mm Lacing
- Needle and thread
- Pliers



### Step 1: Making the Necklace Base



Start by laying the length of cotton trim on top of the pom pom fringe. Use the pliers to open the jump rings. Pierce the open ring through the trims to connect the trim and fringe to the chain. Close each jump ring after it is securely holding the trims and chain together.

For a close fit, attach the jump rings to every other chain link.



When this step is complete, your necklace in progress should look like this!

### Step 2: Thread the Lacing and Attaching the D-Rings



Begin to thread the lacing through the jump rings.

Continue to feed the lacing through the length of the necklace.



Fold the edge of your necklace base over a D-Ring and sew through it to hold it in place. Do this on both sides, cutting off any excess.

### Step 3: Finishing Touches!



Cut the length of grosgrain in half and sew one piece to each D-Ring, taking care to copy the saddle stitching.

Using the jump rings, attach the remaining piece of chain to each side of the necklace base, right below the D-Ring.



**This necklace is great at any length! Use the ribbon to customize a look for you.**
