SCARECROW DOOR HANGER

What you need:

- Ribbon Sewing Needle
- Embroidery Thread
- Glue Gun & Glue Sticks
- Stuffing or Sewing scraps
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Ruler

- Jute Yarn (Vanilla)
- Jute Belting (Natural)
- Black Burlap Foldover
- Cotton Fringe (Natural)
- 2 Black Buttons
- Lightweight Felt

(Yellow, Cashmere Tan, Gold, Walnut Brown, & Orange)






Step 1: Measure & cut four 6" (15.25cm) strips from Jute Belting.



Step 2: Cross Stitch two strips together, side by side, with Green Embroidery Thread.



Step 3: On ONE of the stitched Jute squares, sew a smile with Black Embroidery Thread.



Step 4: Sew on Black Button eyes with Black Embroidery Thread.



Step 5: With the pre stitched Jute squares (shown in Step 2) back to back, sew together leaving the top open.



Step 6: Stuff with either stuffing or fabric, craft or sewing scraps.

Step 7: Glue on Orange Felt nose. (See pattern)





Step 8: Glue Jute yarn "hair", on front and back of head. You will need 24 pieces, 7" (17.75cm) in length.



Step 9: Cut 6.5" (16.5cm) of Cotton Fringe, and glue above the eyes to finish the hairline.



Step 10: Cut out two 6.5"x 5.5" (16.5cm x 14cm) rectangles, and one hat rim. (See pattern)



Step 11: Sew three sides of the two rectangles together (shown in Step10) with Yellow Embroidery Thread.



Step 12: Glue hat rim around the bottom opening.

(Optional:) Add felt patches to front of hat.



Step 13: Thread 13" (33cm) of Black Burlap Foldover through felt hat buckle, and glue to hat.



Step 14: Glue completed hat to top of head.



Step 15: Glue Jute yarn loop, 12" (30.5cm), to top of hat.
