

3-Loop Shamballa Bracelet

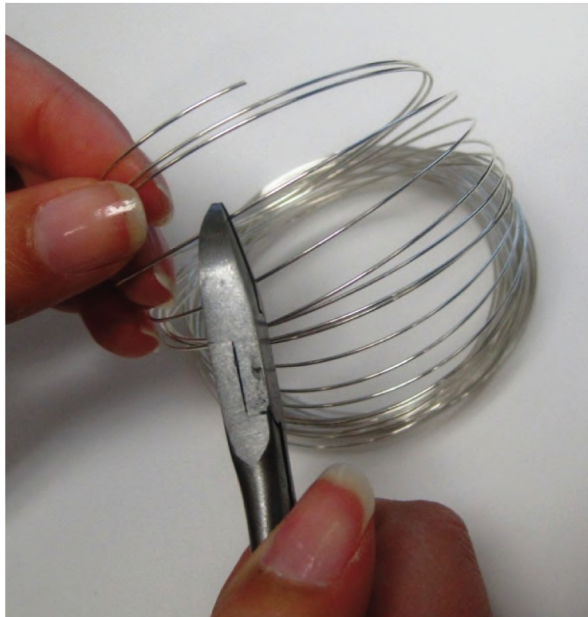


Materials:

- 1 x 10mm Shamballa Bead Strand
- 2 x 4mm x 6mm Crystal Bead Strand
- 1 x Memory Wire in Bracelet Size

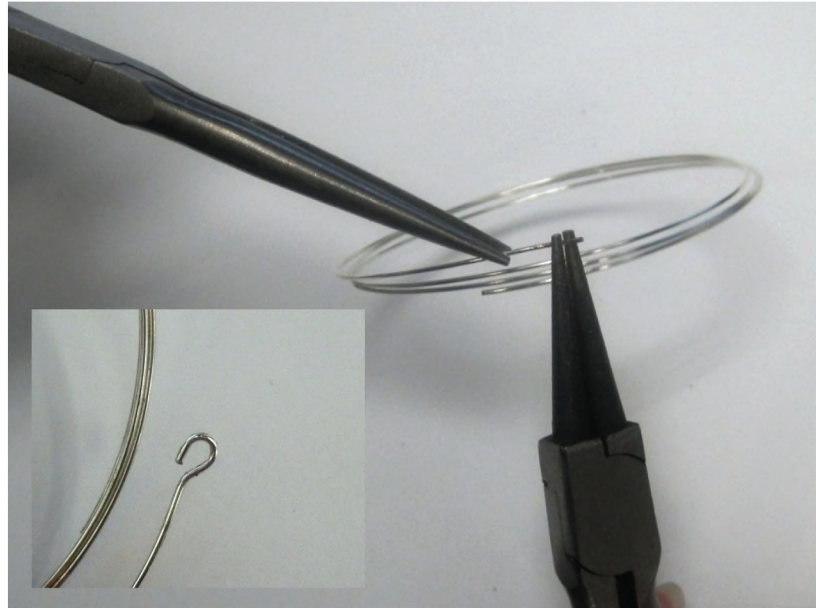
Tools:

- 1 x Round Nose Pliers
- 1 x Long Nose Pliers
- 1 x Wire Cutters



Step 1

Use your wire cutters to cut just over 3 loops of the memory wire for your bracelet.



Step 2

Use your pliers to create a loop at one end of your memory wire. This will prevent your beads from falling off.

Step 3

Plan out the order you want your beads to be in on your bracelet and start feeding the beads on to the memory wire. For this bracelet, I started with the small pearl bead at the end of the shamballa bead strand, followed by 29 crystal beads.



I then added a large pearl bead and a small the shamballa bead strand followed by three crystal beads, then a shamballa bead and a small bicone bead from the shamballa bead strand followed by three crystal beads. I repeated this pattern until there was only the last small pearl bead remaining on the shamballa bead strand. I then added 29 more crystal beads and the last small pearl bead to the end.



Step 4

After you have fed all of your bead onto the memory wire, use your round nose pliers to create a loop on the open end of your strand.

You've made your own beautiful 3-loop shamballa bracelet!



Repeat these steps with all of our shamballa bead colours or create your own designs using the other beads in our collection, and you'll have bracelets to match all of your favourite outfits!

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
