

Tassel Lariat in 3 Ways

Materials

Chain
1 Pair Tassels
2 Open Jump Rings 6mm

Tools

2 Chain Nose Pliers

Variation 1 - Loose Weave

1. Measure out desired length of chain for your necklace.
2. Taking the tassel loop end, weave it in and out of the chain links at one end.
3. To secure the tassel to the chain, hook an open 6mm jump ring to the tassel loop and then to a chain link. Close the jump ring.
4. Repeat for the other end of the chain.

(Note: You can add single bead threaded on ball pins for embellishment. Connect them to chain links using open jump rings.)



Variation 2 - Tight Weave

1. For a different look, weave the tassel loop through more chain links, flattening the links as you go.
2. Keep weaving the loop as far as you can. Open a 6mm jump ring and hook onto the loop end and a chain link. Close the jump ring.
3. Repeat for the other end of the chain.



Variation 3 - Jump Ring Embellishment

1. Close 15 of the 6mm jump rings.
2. Thread the closed jump rings through the tassel loop.
3. Thread the tassel loop through the first link of the end of the chain. Fold over and thread back through the 6mm jump rings again. Pull the loop out of the last jump ring.
4. Hook on the tassel loop end to an open 4mm jump ring.
5. Thread a bead onto a ball pin. Leaving 1cm of wire above the bead, trim the excess. Create a basic loop. Repeat for the other bead.
6. Hook the two bead loops onto the open 4mm jump ring at the tassel loop end. Close the 4mm jump ring.
