

Two Tone Infinity Scarf

What you need:

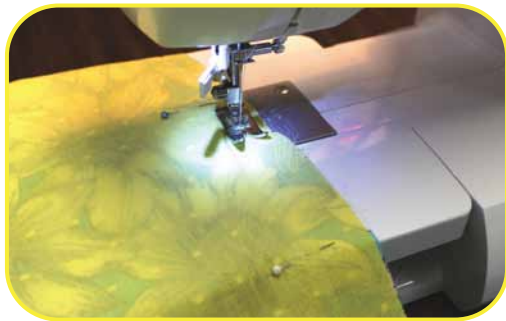
1m of main fabric
1m of contrast fabric
208 cm (82") of trim
Scissors, thread, pins,
sewing machine

What you do:

Cut 1 piece 1m x 1m of
main fabric
Cut 1 piece 1m x 1m of
contrast fabric
Seam allowance 1.25cm (1/2")



1



With right sides together, sew main fabric & contrast fabric along one edge. Press seam open.

Pin & baste trim to the right side of one lengthwise edge, curving the ends of the trim towards the seam allowance as shown.

Fold piece in half lengthwise with right sides together. Sew seam, making sure that you are not stitching over the trim. You will now have a long fabric tube. Press seam open and then flat.

Turn tube right side out. Matching the side seams, pin right sides together. As you pin the tube will start to close, so only pin as far as you can go. Sew the edges together leaving a 10-12cm (4-5") opening.

Press the seam allowances of opening inward. With a needle and thread, handstitch opening closed.
